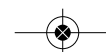

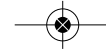

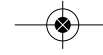

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

You are kindly requested to register on Thursday 4th March between 11 am and 8.30 pm at the Entrance Hall of the CCIB. Alternatively, on 5th and 6th March from 9 am. Upon registration, you will receive a welcome pack and a name badge, which is necessary throughout the Forum to enter all the sessions, the lunch area and the cultural evening.

LANGUAGES

The inauguration and closing sessions will have simultaneous interpreting from Catalan and from/to English, French, Spanish and Arabic. The Agora "Plenary Sessions" and "Workshops" and the Medina "Partners' Contribution" and "Info Sessions" will have simultaneous translation from and to English and French. The Medina "Best Practices" and "Project Ideas" and the material presented in the "Artistic Exchange" will be either in English or French.

MEALS AT CCIB

All lunches will be served at the Meeting Room 211-212 on Level 2 of CCIB. Welcome and Farewell receptions will be served at the Entrance Hall on Level 0.

INTERNET ACCESS

A free wireless connection will be available in all CCIB spaces.

MAIN ADDRESSES AND TRANSPORTATION

The whole programme of the Forum will take place at the CCIB (Rambla Prim 1-17, www.ccib.es, L4 yellow metro stop El Maresme-Forum).

The two main accommodation facilities for the Forum participants are

- Hotel Barcelona Princess (Av. Diagonal 1)
- Hotel Diagonal Zero (Placa de Llevant s/n)

Both of them are at walking distance from the CCIB.

TO REACH THE CCIB/HOTELS FROM THE AIRPORT:

The express bus service (Aerobus) between the airport and the city centre (Plaza Cataluña) is covered from 6:00 to 1:00 (Mon-Fri) and from 6:30 to 1:00 (Sat-Sun) (direction Barcelona), and from 5:30 to 00:15 (Mon-Fri) and from 6:00 to 00:30 (Sat-Sun) (direction airport). Next to Plaza Cataluña, you can take the L4 yellow metro at the Urquinaona station till Maresme-Forum.

In order to reach the city centre from the CCIB, take the yellow metro line L4-LA PAU - TRINITAT NOVA at the EL MARESME | FÒRUM station and get off after 8 stops, at URQUINAONA.

CULTURAL EVENING

The concert on 6th March will be held at the Museu Maritim (Av. de les Drassanes s/n), preceded by a cocktail dinner. In order to reach the Museu Maritim from the CCIB, take the yellow metro line L4-LA PAU - TRINITAT NOVA at EL MARESME | FÒRUM station and get off after 9 stops, at PASSEIG DE GRÀCIA. From there, take the green metro line L3-CANYELLES - ZONA UNIVERSITÀRIA and get off after 3 stops, at DRASSANES.

PARTICIPATION

As participants of the Anna Lindh Forum 2010, you will have the possibility to enjoy two different components: the Agora and the Medina.

The Agora is the place where we will debate and reflect on key issues in the field of intercultural dialogue in the Euro-Mediterranean region and elaborate major recommendations for the intercultural agenda and the future action of the Anna Lindh Foundation.

The Agora will consist of plenary sessions open to all participants, followed by 5 thematic workshops, reflecting ALF strategic fields and aimed at reaching recommendations to be presented at the Closing Session on 7th March.

Each Workshop is divided into 2 groups that will meet simultaneously both on 5th and 6th March.

Most of you have already chosen one workshop and once in Barcelona you will be asked to register in one group (no. 1 or 2) within it.

As we count on your active participation in the group debate, we would highly appreciate your commitment to attend the SAME GROUP on both days.

The Medina is the place where ALF national network members, Euro-Med regional networks, institutions and initiatives, local associations and international NGOs will be invited to share their ideas and their experiences to create new opportunities for intercultural actions and to establish new partnerships.

It will consist of the following 2 static spaces

- *Intercultural Fair*, with presentation stands for ALF network members and other organizations of the Euro-Med region active in ALF strategic fields; and
- *Artistic Exchange*: exhibitions, video & film screenings, installations developed in collaboration with network members and Euro-Med partners

and the following 4 dynamic spaces

- *Info Sessions* on subjects related to intercultural practices (e.g. funding programmes, network management);
- Presentation of *Best Practices* registered among the ALF actions and of its member organizations, outlining positive experiences, but also challenges related to field work;
- Spaces to present *Project Ideas*, debate about them with other participants and look for new partners and developments;
- *Partners' contributions* (e.g. sessions organized by members of ALF networks and partners).

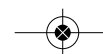

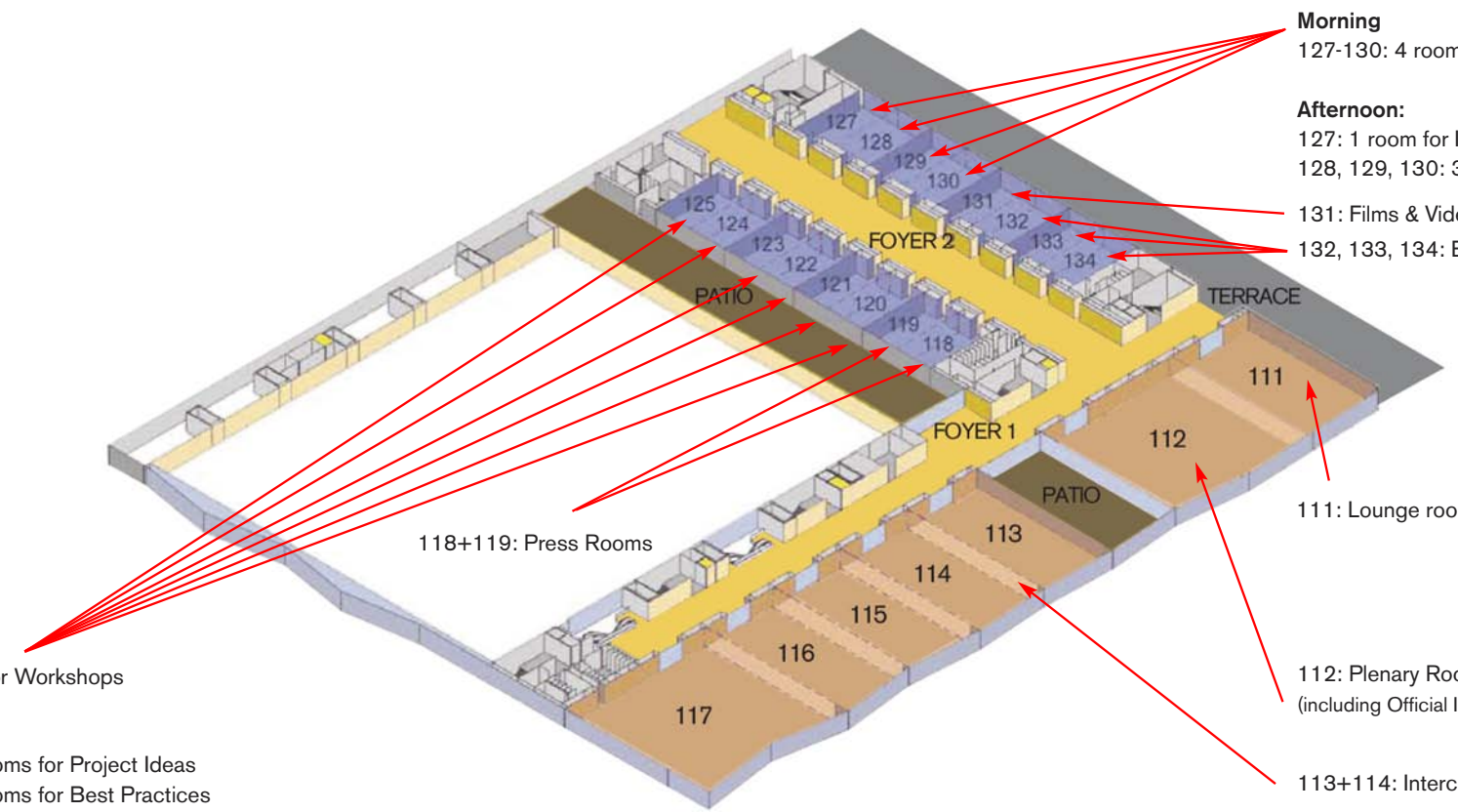
